EU-nationality

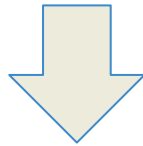
In possession of a valid EU identity card

- Access to all VDAB services
- Unlimited access to the job market
- Possibility to keep your unemployment benefits

NON EU-nationality

RESIDENCE PERMIT

- access to the job market ('yes' 'no' or 'limited')



CONSEQUENCES FOR

- registration and service VDAB
- job possibilities

- emphasis on 'jobs on demand'
- in Dutch

- Dutch courses at CVO
→ In-Gent
- Dutch courses at UGent (UCT)
- Dutch course at VDAB
 - OpStap: intensive Dutch course in preparation of Maatpak/Hogerop
 - Hogerop: intensive job oriented Dutch course + job application training
 - Maatpak: intensive Dutch course in preparation of a higher technical vocational VDAB course

- Dutch course at VDAB
 - BAT : intensive Dutch course in combination with administrative training
 - VOSPA : intensive Dutch course in preparation of the program to become a nurse or caretaker
